Skills Academy aims to address the evolving training needs of all staff across the department. It will provide mandatory courses for practitioners alongside qualifications and development opportunities, but will also look to offer bespoke training solutions for skills and knowledge gaps as they arise.

Pathways

Offering 6 different 'Pathways' - Skills Academy aims to address the full scope of training demand across the department, encouraging staff to enrol on to each relevant pathway as required.

Core Pathway

The core pathway will be open to ALL ASC staff and will consist of mandatory training and courses that will be universally helpful to staff across the department



Student & Newly Qualified Pathway

Open to all AYSE, Apprenticeship and graduate students—the pathway predominantly focuses on providing opportunities to gain experience and support in department.



Career Development Pathway

This pathway is for permanent ASC staff and will provide individuals with the chance to improve the depth and breadth of their knowledge beyond core level. It will also focus on bespoke training



Management Pathway

The management pathway will be open to all permanent ASC staff in leadership roles, to help them build and develop their skills to be more confident and effective managers.



Champion Pathway

Champion roles will be available via application to all permanent ASC staff who wish to develop their knowledge and focus on a particular subject area, such as MCA.



Qualification Pathway

This pathway will be open to all permanent ASC staff, (by application) and will offer fully funded, vocationally relevant qualification opportunities such as AMHP and more.
