Engaging with Spelling

Aimed at English Leads and Teachers supporting in leading spelling in school (Y2 - Y6)

The English spelling system is complex. It is a morpho-phonemic system which combines letter sounds, morphemes, and etymology.

Part 1 will consider the principles of spelling and the key strategies children need to orchestrate to be successful spellers (sound, visual, meaning and kinesthetics cues), and spelling investigations. Delegates will be asked to carry out a gap task.

Part 2 will explore spelling difficulties including carrying out a spelling cue analysis to identify specific needs in spelling, along with sharing outcomes from the gap task. Teachers will need to bring along some writing to analyse.

'If only they knew their tables!' This course will explore strategies for teaching times tables, particularly the 6-, 7-, 8- and 9-times tables - notoriously the most challenging to learn - to support rapid automaticity for fluency. Knowing multiplication tables help with mental arithmetic. It lightens the cognitive overload and allows children focus on mathematical concepts they are learning.
