# **OUR HISTORY**

The Royal United Services Institute has been at the heart of military and security thinking for over 190 years. The Duke of Wellington and other senior military commanders established the Institute in 1831, and some of the most influential thinkers in the 19th and 20th centuries worked or spoke at RUSI. RUSI has been at the centre of policymaking and thinking on defence and security from the rise of the British Empire to its transformation and dissolution, through both World Wars and the Cold War and into today's unsettled world.

In the 21st Century, RUSI re-orientated itself to become a fully-fledged think tank, with research at the heart of its activities and income base. RUSI's research agenda diversified further, analysing the urgent security questions of our age. In 2015, the Institute took the historic step of appointing its first woman and first American Director-General, Dr Karin von Hippel. In addition to its historic focus on military science, nuclear deterrence and international security. RUSI's research portfolio now includes financial crime, terrorism, organised crime and cyber security. The Institute has a key role in providing evidencebased understanding of the 'new disorder' of the contemporary world, and it remains an intrinsic part of the research and debate that surrounds military and security thinking.

Throughout its over 190 years of existence, the Institute has remained faithful to its heritage and founding principles, continuing in its mission to generate evidence-based and independent debate on issues of security and defence.

RUSI is recognised as one of the top global think tanks on security, and in 2020 it was named 'Think Tank of the Year' by Prospect magazine.

## **ROLE PURPOSE**

The Chief Financial Officer is responsible to the Director-General for providing outstanding professional and corporate leadership with regard to financial planning, management and control; risk management and internal control; cyber security; legal and compliance; commercial and company secretarial activities. The role will also support the Director-General and other senior management team members in fulfilling broader objectives within the organisational strategy.

# MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ROLE

- Hold overall responsibility for all of RUSI's financial affairs, for leadership of the Finance Team, and for activities spanning Legal, Risk & Compliance and IT including cyber security in particular.
- Keep RUSI's costs under constant review in pursuit of efficiency and good value and help the Institute achieve its financial goal of an annual surplus and growth of free reserves.
- Ensure all of RUSI's annual audit, accounting and broader regulatory obligations are met to the highest standards and report to the Audit & Risk Committee and the main Board of Trustees on all relevant business.
- Act as a finance business partner to the Senior Management Team, providing financial decision support and practical analysis.
- Lead on the annual business planning process for the Institute and work closely with the DG and Senior Management Team (SMT) in shaping RUSI's strategic and delivery priorities.
- Assume a clear lead on cyber security within the Institute.
- Oversee the management of risk at the Institute and, more broadly, ensure the Institute's governance and compliance processes are sufficiently robust and fit for purpose.
- With other members of the SMT, continue to develop the Institute's business model and ensure this is implemented through bids and proposals submitted by RUSI.
- Ensure the Institute is fully prepared for the Annual General Meeting and that all financial documents and audit are completed and approved in advance by Trustees.

- Understanding of charity accounting and the relevant regulatory frameworks.
- Interest in defence, security and global affairs.
